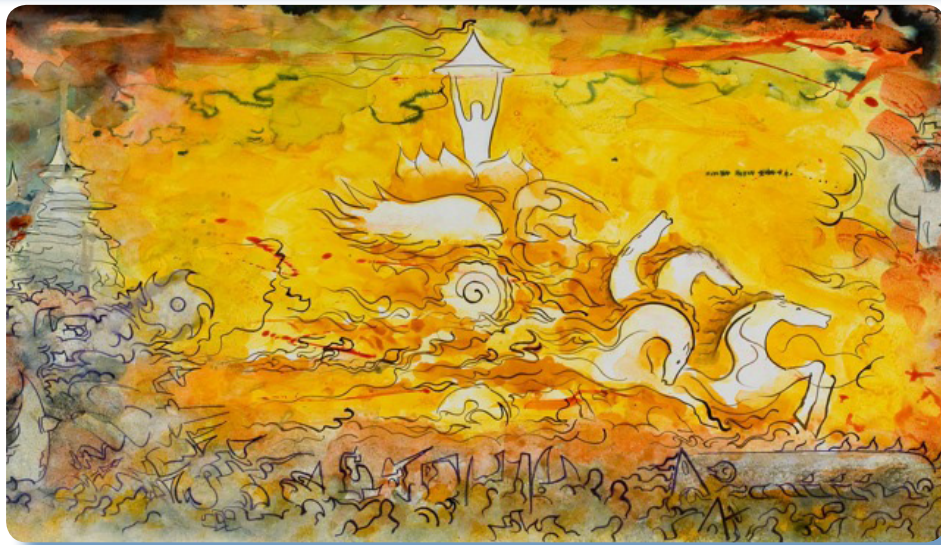

The Gita is a conversation between the small self and the Great Self, between Arjuna and Krishna, spoken in Sanskrit 5000 years ago. This poem of 700 verses has profoundly influenced the course of Hinduism and Yoga.

Starting from the question, 'Who am I?', Krishna teaches a way of life the essence of which is to live in union with the Higher Self.

- What is life? is the subject of JNANA Yoga.
- Where is peace? is the subject of KARMA Yoga.
- Is there true love? is the subject of BHAKTI Yoga.

Ranchor Prime is author of Bhagavad Gita: Talks Between the Soul and God and a dozen other books on sacred wisdom. He discovered the Gita when he was twenty and has lived with it for forty years. He travelled widely in India, where he led environmental projects to rescue sacred sites. He lives in London, where he founded Fitzrovia Press, dedicated to publishing books about the spirit.
